

Said to be the *oldest wood-frame home in* Keosauqua, Bonneyview offers a rare opportunity to own a truly one-of-a-kind piece of lowa history. Perched above the Des Moines River, this lovingly restored property blends historic significance with timeless beauty.

The home features an attached 11'9" x 13'9" summer kitchen, a covered back porch overlooking the Des Moines river, and a stone-walled garden with a small orchard boasting pear, apricot, peach, and plum trees. Every detail of Bonneyview has been carefully restored to reflect its original eras—1840, 1856, 1906, and the 1950s—including the masonry, siding, windows, sills, and roofing.

The central structure, originally built by William Hadden, offers three rooms downstairs and two upstairs. In 1856, the addition towards town expanded the home, followed by porches and additional upper-level rooms. With its straight, clean lines, centrally located chimney, and expansive open porch, Bonneyview reflects the character of many pioneer homes across lowa.

Named by Estelle Bonney Walker, an early owner, this home is not just a residence—it's a storybook of lowa's past. Whether you're drawn to its historical legacy, architectural character, or river views, Bonneyview is a treasure waiting for its next chapter.
