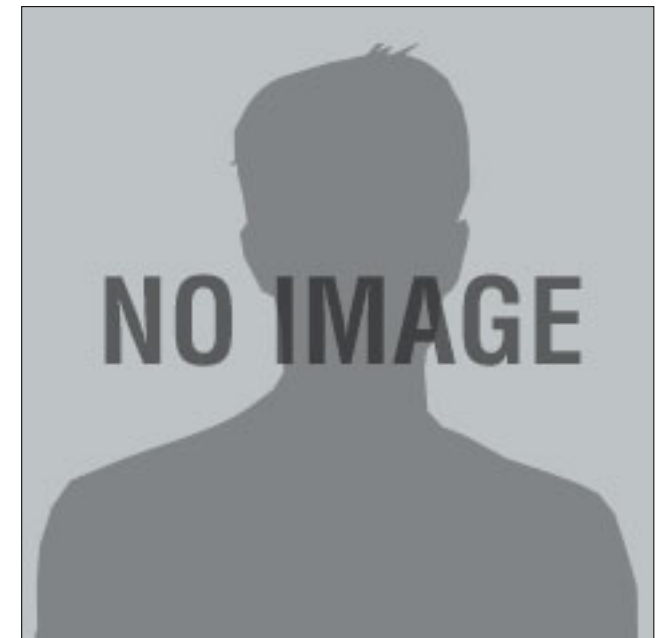

This home "Bonnyview" is said to be the oldest house in Keosauqua, Iowa. You can sit on the beautiful screened in porch and just watch the Des Moines River flow by. Includes a 11'9" X 13'9" Summer kitchen & a patio. The central part of Bonnyview, named by Estelle Bonney Walker, an early owner of the house, is the original house erected by William Hadden, and consists of three rooms downstairs and two upstairs. The part toward town was added to this structure in 1856, and porches and additional upstairs rooms were added later. Bonnyview is typical of many Iowa homes built in pioneer days. It has a large open porch, straight, almost severe lines, and a centrally located chimney. This home for sale is located in the historic Villages of Van Buren County.
